A Constitutional Amendment to establish the Elections Committee as an independent, constitutional body within the ASUCD.

Section 1. The ASUCD Senate hereby places the following Constitutional Amendment on the Fall 2018 ballot:

An act to amend the ASUCD Constitution by placing the following amendment before the vote of the ASUCD membership on the Fall 2018 ballot.

### **BACKGROUND:**

Section 1. Should both Constitutional Amendment #55, the "Constitutional Cleanup Amendment," and Constitutional Amendment #58, the "Student Advocate Amendment" reach the required threshold for their passage, the ASUCD membership hereby enacts Article VII, Section 2 of the ASUCD Constitution as follows:

Section 2.      (1)      There shall exist an ASUCD Elections Committee (hereafter referred to as the Elections Committee), which shall consist of nine (9) members, including one (1) Chair, who shall serve terms of no longer than one (1) year but may be reappointed after their term.

- (a) Members of the Elections Committee shall be appointed by a four-fifths (4/5) approval of an Interviewing Committee consisting of the ASUCD President, the ASUCD Senate President Pro Tempore, the ASUCD Judicial Council Chair, and two (2) designees from the Elections Committee not currently reapplying for the position.
- (2) Any undergraduate member of ASUCD in good academic standing based on Grade Point Average (GPA) shall be eligible to hold office in the Elections Committee.
- (3) The Elections Committee shall be responsible for arranging, implementing, and publicizing all ASUCD Elections and Referenda, and enforcing regulations thereafter passed through ASUCD enacted legislation.
